

# NUHW BARGAINING UPDATE

On May 20 and 21 our bargaining team met with Sutter-CPMC management to continue bargaining our contract.

During those bargaining sessions, Sutter-CPMC modified their takeaway proposals only slightly.

For example, they raised their 2.25% wage increase to 2.5%.

We are still far part on the issues that matter most to us. Sutter-CPMC is still proposing higher costs on our health insurance plan, has not agreed to retro pay or heavy duty pay, and has not signed a ban on subcontracting.

Our next bargaining session is June 12.

**Our message to Sutter-CPMC is clear: If they're not serious about giving us the contract we deserve on June 12, we will be moving forward with the strike.**



"We don't want to strike, but we will.

Their terms are unacceptable and this has gone on long enough.

It's time to settle a contract because we are ready to strike."
