USC pays many Keck Hospital caregivers wages so low that they qualify for taxpayer-funded programs like food stamps. And the health coverage plan is too costly for many Keck caregivers, forcing them to rely on Medi-Cal.

USC denies its Keck caregivers the retirement and tuition assistance benefits it offers to all other members of its "Trojan Family" of USC employees. Hundreds of Keck workers have no retirement savings at all.
