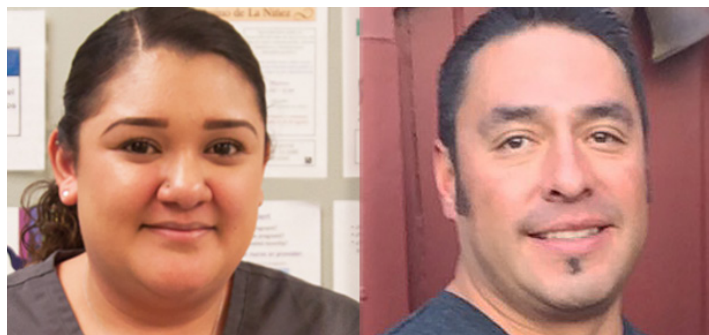
Queen of the Valley workers send delegation to CEO
