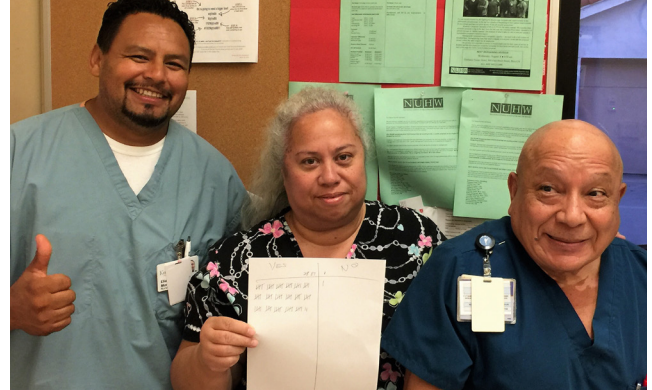


INFORMATIONAL PICKET AUTHORIZED!



We voted nearly unanimously to stage an informational picket if management continues refusing to address our core concerns.

Management's last proposal of 2 percent to 2.25 percent raises is not enough. We need to be ready to take collective action and let management know we are serious about fighting for wage increases that keep up with the cost of living.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the date for the informational picket?

We have not yet set a date. We plan to picket if we fail to make good progress at our next bargaining session. We will let you know if we picket and which date the picket will be held.

What is an informational picket?

Informational picketing is a collective action organized by the workers to protest management's unfair labor practices. It's not a strike. We will all work our normal shifts and join the picket either before work, after work or during our lunch breaks.

Who can participate in an informational picket line?

All of us. If you are off work the day of the picket, you should come to the picket line. If you are working you can picket during your break.

Will I be retaliated against by management?

No. Federal law gives us the right to picket. We staged a picket before winning our last contract.
