## **WHY WE'RE PICKETING**

- During our last Bargaining session, management said, in explaining why they would give a lower wage increase to some employees, *“Different jobs have different levels of value and importance to our organization. Some jobs have more value than others.”*
- Management’s proposals don’t keep up with the cost of living.
- Kindred’s last proposal excludes long term employees from getting any wage increase

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **What is an informational picket?**

Informational picketing is a collective action organized by the workers to protest management’s unfair labor practices. It’s not a strike. We will all work our normal shifts and join the picket either before work, after work or during our lunch breaks.

### **Who can participate in an informational picket line?**

All of us. If you are off work the day of the picket, you should come to the picket line. If you are working you can picket during your break.

### **Will I be retaliated against by management?**

No. Federal law gives us the right to picket. We staged a picket before winning our last contract.

We deserve a fair contract that recognizes our commitment, skills and dedication to our patients. Unfortunately, based on the proposals, management at Kindred Brea does not respect us or value us.
