May 17, 2018

We had a productive bargaining session with management on May 17.

We reached a tentative agreement on New Organizing Rights and made progress on union recognition, equal employment opportunities, new employee orientation and categories of employment.

We've had several clinicians attend every bargaining session, and have been making good progress as a result. The lesson? When we show up, management sees that we're all united and committed to this process, and are more moved to negotiate with us. We are hopeful to continue making progress when we meet again in June.
