AMBULATORY CLINICS: RAISES AND RATIFICATION BONUSES

Workers ratified their first contract at the Keck Ambulatory clinics and are now waiting for their ratification bonus and scheduled wage scale raises.

Keck Ambulatory clinic workers should expect to receive their raises effective 05/13/2018 and paid on June 1, 2018 payroll. Please take note of this important date and contract Ian Woolverton for more information.

KECK AND NORRIS WORKERS DELIVER "WHATEVER-IT-TAKES" PETITION

Workers delivered more than 750 signed petitions from Keck Medical Center and Norris Cancer Hospital demanding that Keck bargain in good faith. Tentative agreements have been reached on the following 20 articles:

Preamble

Mission statement of the union

Article 2: Union representation Guarantees union rep access to facility and guaranteed paid steward time

Article 3: Employee status

Defines a full time worker and threshold
for part time status in contract

Article 4a: Seniority

Defines seniority as most recent date of hire uninterrupted with employer.

Article 4b: Reduction in force Recall rights and definition of rights to recall within 1 year of notice.

Article 5: Job vacancies and postings Provision that allow incumbent employees to use years of seniority in job bidding, usually within 7 days.

Article 6: Non discrimination Employer agrees to abide by lawful provisions

Article 7: union no discrimination Employer agrees to union rights and non-retaliation for union activity.

Article 10: Discipline

Employer agrees to just cause standard when discipline is issued. Not relevant after 12 months.

Article 17: Health and Safety Employer agrees to adhere to all regulatory rules and regulations regarding safety in the workplace.

Article 18: Education

Keeps current practice and extends same benefits during contract period.

Article 19: Leaves of absence employer agrees to add aunt/uncle to bereavement definition of family.

Article 20: Successorship
Employer agrees to be sold as p

Employer agrees to be sold as package, making union contract enforceable with any or a new employer.

Article 21: Management rights

Union agree that employer has certain management responsibilities that are reserved for them during this agreement.

Article 24: Work stoppage

Union and employer agree to no strikes during contract period. Union maintains rights to picket during contract.

Article 26: Savings clause

Employer agrees to preserve negotiated standard in CBA if federal or state laws changes

Article 29: Employment and income security

Employer agrees to make every effort to avoid displacement of employees

Article 35: Bargaining unit work Employer agrees that it will not allow supervisors to perform bargaining unit work for duration of agreement.

Article 31: Uniforms

Employer agrees to provide workplace uniforms is dress code is required.

Article 32: Meals and rest periods Employer agrees to obey law and rules on meal breaks and penalties if lunch is missed.

AROUND THE UNION

Several new NUHW units just started bargaining recently. Mental health professionals at **Richmond Area Multi-Services** in San Francisco have presented all of their proposals except wage scales, which they expect to finalize soon. Counselors at Elk Grove School District just outside Sacramento presented all of their proposals at the first session. And substance use disorder counselors and other members at Janus of Santa Cruz, have completed two bargaining sessions, as have members at Santa Cruz's Dominican Hospital.

Caregivers at Brius Healthcare's **Novato Healthcare Center** voted 96 percent to ratify a three-year contract that includes improved healthcare and vacation benefits, more sick leave, a performance bonus, protection against unjust termination, and 7 percent wage increases over the life of the contract.

Bargaining continues for seven Kaiser biorepository workers in Berkeley, for workers at Prime's West Anaheim Medical Center, and for workers at Kindred San Diego.

Bargaining for **Sodexo** workers at **Lakewood** and **Los Alamitos** medical centers has been moving slowly, but members are preparing to discuss wages and benefits at the next sessions in mid-May.

And several units are preparing to begin bargaining soon: **The Sequoias**, an assisted living facility in Portola Valley; **North American** nursing homes in Northern California; and three of our Kaiser units — **IBHS**, **Psych–Social**, and **Healthcare Professionals** — are gearing up for bargaining scheduled to begin this summer.

STEWARDS TAKE PART IN ONE-DAY TRAINING

Dozens of new stewards attended a one-day training on their legal duties and representational obligations. Attendees from Keck Ambulatory clinics, Fountain Valley Regional Hospital, Kaiser hospitals, and other Southern



California facilities learned new strategies for enforcing our contracts.
