WHY WE'RE PICKETING

- During our last bargaining session, management said, in explaining why they would give a lower wage increase to some employees, *“Different jobs have different levels of value and importance to our organization. Some jobs have more value than others.”*
- Management’s proposals don’t keep up with the cost of living.
- Kindred’s last proposal excludes long term employees from getting any wage increase.

STRIKE VOTE TO BE TAKEN ON PICKET LINE

We will be taking a vote during the informational picket on whether to authorize our Bargaining Committee to call a one-day strike if we don’t make significant progress at bargaining.

The Bargaining Committee would determine the date of the strike.

We deserve a fair contract that recognizes our commitment, skills, and dedication to our patients. Unfortunately, based on the proposals, management at Kindred Brea does not respect us or value us.
