NOMINATE AND ELECT YOUR SHOP STEWARDS!

Now that we have our new contract, it's time to elect our Shop Steward Team. Shop Stewards are your co-workers, who will be trained to be the first line of defense in working with you to solve issues, provide union representation during investigatory or disciplinary meetings; keep coworkers united and informed; and enforce the Union Contract.

Here's what you need to do to make sure your department is represented:

- 1. Start talking with your co-workers to decide who would be the best person to represent your department. Every department and shift need a shop steward.
- 2. Fill out and submit your nomination form by Thursday Nov 15. Forms are available at the bulletin board or you can get one from a Bargaining Team member.
- 3. Elections will be held on Monday Nov 19 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 6 to 8 p.m. The results will be announced at the end of the election.

Members can only vote for their own department's nominee(s).

KIN CARE: HERE'S HOW IT WORKS

Kin Care is protected leave that can be used to take care of a family member. This means that you cannot face any retribution for using it. The law allows you to use up to 50 percent of your yearly PTO accrual for Kin Care. It comes out of your PTO, but there are no points or penalties if you need to use it.
