By a unanimous vote, NUHW members at Marin General Hospital have authorized their NUHW Bargaining Team to call for and schedule an informational picket and rally outside the hospital if and when such a move becomes necessary at the bargaining table.

While it's fairly common for a vote like this to result in a 90% or 95% or even 98% margin for YES, it's rare that such a vote produces 100% YES. We are, quite literally, all in this together.

An informational picket is NOT a strike or work stoppage. It's a picket line outside the hospital that we join before work, after work, and on our lunch breaks. An informational picket shows management that we are willing to fight for a contract that safeguards our health insurance.

We will keep you all posted about how things go at the bargaining table in the weeks to come.

We're proud to be leading the way in standing up against management's attempts to gut our well-deserved health insurance plan. This vote demonstrates just how united and committed we are to do what it takes to fight back!
