LAKEWOOD UPDATES: VACATION REQUESTS

The union and management agreed on establishing a new vacation request system. The previous system created significant problems, with many dates requested up to a year in advance. Under the new system, employees will be able to plan their vacation within windows of six months. This new system will also give management ample advance notice to plan for operational needs.

SAFETY & HEALTH COMMITTEE AT FOUNTAIN VALLEY

In our Fountain Valley Contract, Article 10 requires the employer to maintain a safe working environment, and supplies and equipment required by law. Per Section 1, "A joint Safety and Health Committee ("Committee") will be established. The committee will be composed of a minimum of four (4) members of the bargaining unit selected by the union and a maximum of four (4) members of management selected by the employer."



The first committee meeting was held on April 29. Among the issues we discussed were proper job training for EVS workers and a more organized storage system for food service. Proactively addressing issues like these will help ensure safety standards for patients and workers alike.
