

KAISER PERMANENTE HEALTHCARE PROS BARGAINING UPDATE

At our previous negotiation session, Kaiser representatives told us they were in support of additional career ladder steps in principle and would present counter proposals to us at our next session. However, when we met on Monday, they rejected our career ladder proposal completely and didn't come prepared with any counter.

While we were meeting with the local management, Kaiser executives from Northern and Southern California met to discuss an economic package proposal for all three bargaining units. We are expecting management to give us a finalized proposal early next week, after which we will determine our next steps.

If the proposal is grossly inadequate, our three bargaining committees may decide to give Kaiser a ten-day notice of an open-ended strike. A majority of members have already signed the strike authorization petition. If you haven't signed it yet, we encourage you to contact your rep to do so.
