

QUEEN OF THE VALLEY BARGAINING UPDATE

SEPTEMBER 9, 2019



NO MORE DELAYS – FAIR CONTRACT NOW!

We showed up for bargaining on September 4, on time and prepared, after Queen management had cancelled our previous session. Our agreed upon meeting time came and went, with no sign of management. They finally appeared at 2 P.M., two hours late.

Management brought with them only a presentation about the retirement proposal they had given us the month before. They had no response on any of the proposals we had made more than two weeks earlier.

This level of disrespect is unacceptable – and it betrays the mission of our hospital.

We're fighting for a fair contract that ensures the Queen upholds its values: compassion, dignity, justice, excellence, and integrity. Living out those values

requires adequate staffing, fair wages and benefits, and safe working conditions for all — especially our long term co-workers, who have given many years of service to our community.

We're ready to negotiate a contract that meets those needs. Why aren't Providence St. Joseph executives willing to do the same?

Our next bargaining session is scheduled for Monday, September 16. We've had enough with the delays and stalling. We expect to see Queen management on-time and prepared to bargain in good faith around the important issues facing our hospital and our patients.
