BARGAINING UPDATE OCTOBER 16, 2019

Here is an update from our third bargaining session on October 10:

We Responded **Management Proposed** Wage An insultingly low wage increase: We lowered our proposed yearly raise from Increases 6% to 5%, and changed the wage scale we are 1st year: 1.5%, proposing so that the anniversary raise for 2nd year: 1.5% workers on their 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 10th 3rd year: 1.25% and 15th year anniversaries would be 2% For someone making only \$16 an hour, instead of 3%. the first raise would be only 24 cents! Health Two Kaiser health insurance plans that We continued to insist on our zero deductible. are inferior to the Kaiser plan we have Insurance low co-pay health plan but proposed that workers would pay 10% of the cost and proposed: management would pay 90%. 1. Basic Plan: Deductible of \$5,000 Cost to employee: \$53 per month 2. "Premium Plan: Deductible of \$1,500 Cost to employee: \$183 per month
