EVS NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE

On October 15, our elected EVS NUHW Bargaining Team met with PTMC management and Human Resources. Our bargaining team proposed:

• Wage scales and raises for EVS technicians, EVS floor technicians, and lead EVS technicians from start to year 15, just like other NUHW PTMC members.

A Patient Care Committee



meeting in November between management and EVS leaders to discuss improvements in staffing and supplies.

• Changing start times for first shift to from 6 A.M. to 2:30 P.M., and for second shift from 2 to 10:30 P.M.

Management's response was disappointing:

- They proposed a wage scale that's lower than what many of us currently make, and no increase in 2019.
- Management said more than once that they did not want to address staffing and supplies during negotiations.
- No change to the shift start times.
