

SFNC WORKERS PICKET AND VOTE TO STRIKE!

Workers vote by 95% to authorize a one day strike

NUHW members at San Francisco Nursing Center held a successful informational picket on Tuesday, December 3, showing their commitment to winning a contract with fair raises and improvements in health insurance, vacation, and holiday benefits.

The picket was covered by a local newspaper and Filipino TV station. San Francisco Supervisor Ahsha Safai joined us, as well as members of the Filipino Community Center.

We also voted on December 3, by an overwhelming 95%, to authorize our Bargaining Committee to call for a 1-day strike if we don't make progress in bargaining.

Our next bargaining session is scheduled for December 10. The Bargaining Committee is now authorized to schedule a strike if management is not willing to offer fair raises and improved benefits.

We deserve a fair contract with decent wage increases and better health insurance so that we can afford to go to the doctor.

We do important work here, taking care of our patients.

And we'll strike if we have to."
