Kindred management notified us on December 5 that it is "withdrawing" its proposal to eliminate our sick time!

Stewards and activists at Kindred Hospitals represented by NUHW coordinated collective actions to push back. Workers wore **HANDS OFF OUR SICK DAYS!** stickers and organized groups of workers to confront local management.

We know that Kindred only backed off because management knew we were ready to fight to defend our sick days. When we gave notice that we would begin leafleting outside Kindred Brea and Westminster on December 9 and 10, management finally backed down.

What's next? The fight is not over

Management has given in for now, but they said they will propose cutting our sick days during the next contract negotiations, which start this spring for the RNs, RTs, Rad Techs and Lab workers at the Kindred in San Leandro. We must stay united and keep building our power to fight the next battle with Kindred management.

When we fight, we win!
