Tenet Healthcare is a Fortune 500 company, but its practices are harming our communities and failing to adequately protect its patients and workers from contracting COVID-19. Despite reporting a \$2.2 billion cash reserve, Tenet is:

- Refusing to implement best practice COVID-19 safety protocols, such as testing all newly-admitted patients.
- Outsourcing hundreds of jobs including critical work disinfecting the hospital during a pandemic — to a subcontractor that pays poverty wages.
- Underpaying workers and charging more for their health insurance than they can afford to pay.

Now, workers at Tenet Hospitals in Fountain Valley, Los Alamitos, and Lakewood are banding together to improve conditions for themselves and the patients they serve. They are seeking:

- A COVID-19 testing policy that mandates regular testing of all workers, immediate testing of any worker exposed to the virus and mandatory testing of all newly-admitted patients.
- New labor contracts that provide affordable health care and market wages — and bring in-house the housekeepers and dietary workers who are struggling to survive making on average 30 percent less than they would make if they worked directly for the Tenet hospital.
