



**IBHS Bargaining Update
May 20, 2022**

We will be convening our first of two IBHS Town Halls at 9 a.m. Saturday, May 21 to update everyone on bargaining and discuss our IBHS stewards and Bargaining Committee seeking authorization to issue a 10-day notice to Kaiser for an open-ended strike. We will then explain the process for members to vote on the strike authorization and answer questions about it. Immediately after the meeting, we will send out written information on how to cast your vote.

Shortly before the Town Hall begins at 9 a.m., everyone will receive a call asking them to remain on the line if they wish to participate. Anyone who misses the call will receive a message with instructions on how to join the Town Hall. If for some reason you do not receive a call or message, you can listen in on the meeting (but will not be able to ask questions) by calling 540-409-4375 Ext. 81993# anytime after 9 a.m.

Also, attached is an updated side-by-side comparison of our bargaining proposals and Kaiser's.
