

IBHS BARGINING UPDATE MAY 10, 2022

Yesterday, we had the most productive discussion to date regarding our proposals to address workload and access issues. Kaiser's management team was attentive and seemed genuinely interested in understanding both the rationale and the mechanics of our proposals.

Since Kaiser's bargaining team is primarily psychiatry management, many of their concerns focused on how they might operationalize our proposals for the psychiatry department. We addressed these concerns and also let them know we are ready to work collaboratively to implement any changes to this section of the contract.

We also spent a good portion of our time explaining the importance of having contractual language covering departments outside of psychiatry that would ensure all employees have adequate time in their schedules to perform all of their required duties and tasks during their scheduled workday.

After five full hours of discussion, our sense is that, while attentive, management remains resistant to increasing IPC time in providers' schedules. We made sure they understood we could make no further modifications in our proposals unless and until they agreed to increase IPC time and asked them to have a proposal for us at our next session this Friday.
