

IBHS bargaining update January 14, 2022

Earlier this week, we had our first session of bargaining in the new year. Rather than giving an update of that session, where very little happened, we decided to prepare an update on the status of bargaining to date. Attached is a side-by-side comparison which gives a synopsis of the proposals we have given Kaiser since bargaining started and their response to each. The small handful of proposals initiated by Kaiser are also included. You will notice that Kaiser has not made a wage proposal, nor have they responded to any of our economic proposals. When we do receive an economic package, we will update the side-by-side comparison.

The more of us who accurately document our patients' needs for sooner appointments, the harder it will be for Kaiser to continue publicly claiming they have no access issues and to avoid hiring sufficient staff.
