COVID INFECTIONS UPDATE

As of January 8, Kindred management reported that a total of four NUHW members tested positive for COVID. Two have recovered and are ready to return to work, one is in quarantine at home, and one is in the hospital.

Management reported there are no COVIDpositive patients or PUIs.

COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

Last week, the second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine began to be distributed to Kindred Brea employees. Approximately 47 NUHW members at Brea have been vaccinated so far.

MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE

Effective January 1, 2021, the minimum wage at Kindred Hospital Brea for NUHW members is \$14.15 per hour. All employees earning less will be brought up to this new minimum wage rate. For example, an employee with a current rate of \$ 13.80 per hour will receive a raise of 35 cents per hour.

NUHW UNION ELECTIONS

This year we will elect the leaders who will lead our Union for the next three years. Members can nominate themselves or others to serve on the NUHW Executive Board. All members are eligible to vote in the election.

The election notification was emailed to all members last month. The email includes all the instructions for nominating and voting, so that everyone can take part in the elections.

Nominating petitions are due by January 19, 2021. Petitions can be mailed, faxed (510-834-2019) or emailed to nuhwofficerelection@ nuhw.org. Due to COVID, legible photos of nomination petitions will be accepted. Voting will take place in early February.
