National Union of Healthcare Workers Endorses Aaron Peskin for Mayor of San Francisco

NUHW empowers its members to endorse political candidates. Earlier this month, local NUHW members interviewed mayoral candidates and reviewed their answers to the union's questionnaire before recommending that the union's democratically elected executive board endorse Supervisor Peskin as the union's top choice for mayor.

"I believe healthcare is a human right, and that housing is healthcare. By increasing affordable housing in our city, increasing the number of shelter beds available, and helping people access treatment for drug misuse, we can give the gift of a healthier community to the San Francisco of tomorrow," President of the Board of Supervisors Aaron Peskin said. "We can achieve a healthier, safer city through additional medics, emergency room nurses, mental health providers, drug treatment specialists, and 911 call operators."
