QUEEN MANAGEMENT:

PROVIDE COVID TESTING TO KEEP US AND OUR PATIENTS SAFE!



In August we proposed to Queen management that, along with other improvements to our health and safety, demanded regular, universal COVID-19 testing for all staff.

Last week, the California Department of Public Health (CPDH) issued regulations requiring all acute care hospitals to test all staff for COVID-19 **every week**, beginning December 14. What's Queen's response now? They asked for an extension, claiming they need more time to come up with a plan, and they may even try to **ignore these requirements that we've been demanding for months.**

These are the same requirements CDPH placed on Skilled Nursing Facilities, and have been shown to dramatically decrease the number of outbreaks among staff and patients in these facilities.

Now, we are in the middle of a major surge in Napa County. Even though healthcare workers get priority, it will likely take months before we have enough vaccines for all staff. **Testing is a commonsense way to keep us and our patients safe, and Providence (with its \$12 billion in cash reserves) has the resources to do it.**

We put our lives on the line to take care of our patients. Why won't Providence and Queen management take care of us?

In October, we overwhelmingly voted to authorize an informational picket. Stewards are going to examine all options to hold hospital management accountable -- be on the lookout for next steps!
