## **NO PROVIDENCE LAYOFFS!**



## **INFORMATIONAL PICKET WEDNESDAY APRIL 28**

11 AM to 1 PM and 4 PM to 6 PM in front of the Queen

Entering year 2 of this pandemic, Providence has pushed multiple rounds of layoffs — most recently 6 emergency techs, 4 patient cooks, and a transcriptionist. These continued cuts make our hospital less safe and undermine patient care.

Providence is trying to force these cuts on our community while they continue to profit amid the pandemic. OSHPD filings show Queen made an operating profit of \$27 million in 2020. Providence ended the year with their cash reserves having grown to \$15.3 billion.

## These cuts are not necessary!

We've successfully pushed back during previous rounds of layoffs, but this time we need to make clear to Providence: with the support of the Napa community, we reject these cuts to our hospital and patient care.

A picket is not a strike or work stoppage. It means that on breaks, lunches, or while off shift, we will picket in front of the hospital. Friends and family are welcome!
