SUTTER CARE AT HOME BARGAINING UPDATE

At our session on May 30, we were once again joined by the Federal Mediator. Below is a summary of what occurred:

- The bargaining committee submitted a wage supposal, which still places employees on the scale according to their years of service and has a minimum increase of 6% in year one.
 - There was no response from the employer on wages.
- 2. The employer presented a proposal on ESL & FSA, but it largely represented changes that were already agreed to verbally by the employer.
- We also discussed productivity. They still deny the existence of a point system and told us that if we continue to insist on raising this issue it will cause negotiations to last an additional two years.
