BARGAINING UPDATE

November 14, 2022

On Monday November 14, we held negotiations. Sutter countered on several different proposals.

Sutter's counters:

1. Corrective Action
2. Position Posting and Filling of Vacancies
3. Reclassification
4. Seniority and Introductory Period
5. Employee Evaluations

Sutter is still being difficult when it comes to scheduling dates and times for bargaining. They want to hold bargaining during work hours but we are proposing that we rotate between sessions so that if one session is during work hours then the next would be outside of work hours. We continue to urge Sutter to make the process of negotiations move more quickly.

We are currently working on setting up our next bargaining dates. As always, we will keep you updated on any developments.
