As a next step, we're having a membership meeting at 5:30 p.m., Thursday, January 18 to talk about potentially holding an informational picket and how best to advance our contract campaign. If there's consensus in favor of holding a picket, we would then take a formal vote to authorize a picket to be held at a later date.

NOTE: An informational picket is NOT a strike or a work stoppage. It's a picket line we join during our non-working hours (before/after shift, during lunch or breaks, or on days off) to inform the public about issues hapenning in our workplace.
