

READY TO STRIKE!

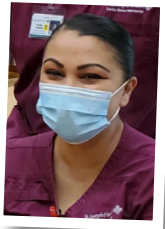
We care for Sonoma County; Providence needs to care about us!

Members who are at work Sunday night or whose shifts start before the strike on Monday morning will stop working at 6:00 A.M. It is management's responsibility to be prepared for that and your need to give report early.

The strike officially ends at 6:00 A.M. on Saturday, July 25. Members who are scheduled to work Friday night or Saturday morning will report to work at 6:00 A.M. on Saturday morning. Management cannot require any member to work for all five days of the strike. Any employee of the hospital who is not an NUHW member also has the legal right to honor a picket line for any of the five days that we are picketing.

If you have health concerns that make it hard to join the strike line, you can join the car caravan each day at 10 A.M. and 2 P.M. in front of the hospital.
