BARGAINING UPDATE

JUNE 20, 2024

On Monday, June 17, we met with Sarkis Vartanian, Kerianne Caligiure, Tim Schulze and Judy Saito from AHMC Seton Administration to resume negotiations of our Healthcare Benefits.

We maintained our last proposal of a 50 percent reduction in cost for the PPO for anybody who needs it, regardless of distance from the hospital, for the life of the contract. The current EPO plan is still lacking, despite the hospital's efforts to expand into additional IPAs.

AHMC received our proposal and is considering options to reduce the cost of the PPO further.



“It does feel like AHMC is understanding more of our needs, but some of the suggestions management made in our discussion did not yet reflect the importance of caring for those of us with families or dependents. We have opened ourselves to negotiate other options as AHMC improves this EPO plan, but it is vital for the safety and health of our families that services improve in the hospital and that the PPO plan is accessible to everyone.”
