AHMC SEEKING TAKEAWAY OF HARD-WON UNION PROTECTIONS

While our Bargaining Committee has made good progress on getting AHMC to provide a medical plan that is the same as our current medical plans (including the 35-mile transportation and bridge provisions), management is holding firm on several takeaways that are very problematic, including:

-  Reduced retirement plan contributions
-  A one-year wage freeze (with no step progressions)
-  Major reductions to our PTO/Extended Sick Leave benefits
-  Elimination of Subcontracting prohibitions

We will continue our efforts to achieve the best contract possible for the frontline caregivers who take care of our patients and our community. We return to the bargaining table on Friday, July 3, and will continue bargaining into the holiday weekend. Please stay tuned for further details.
