Within 60 days, Sutter has to pay us all of what we're owed, WITH INTEREST.

(And the interest rate grows from 5% to 7%).

The charge we filed with the Labor Board has resulted in a victory.

Not only does Sutter have to pay us what we're owed because they denied us our 2022 merit raises, but they also have to declare: "WE WILL NOT threaten to withhold your merit increase, or fail to pay you your merit increase if you vote to join a union or because you are represented by a union."

They have 60 days to pay up.
