15. Clinical Ladder for Physical Therapist Assistants

1. Physical Therapist Assistant I: Entry-level Physical Therapist Assistant.

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2. Physical Therapist Assistant II (Senior Physical Therapist Assistant). Performs all tasks of Physical Therapist Assistant I and must have at least the following have accomplished the following criteria and provide this level of service ongoing annually:

- a. <u>Clinical experience</u>: Must have at least two (2) four (4) years of clinical experience, two of the four (4) years must be in the same clinical setting.
- b. <u>Professional Growth and Learning</u>: Must have additional Certification in a clinically relevant area, <u>included including</u> but not limited to: ATC, CSCS, or Credentialed Clinical Instructor by APTA.
- c. Teaching and Mentoring.
 - Must have been a clinical instructor for at least one (1) full time PTA Student(s) or the equivalent, OR and
 - ii. Must have mentored or provided manager approved professionally relevant instruction to the physical therapy staff, other professionals, or community members for a minimum of 20 hours; this may include but is not limited to inservices, professional presentations, and community outreach.
- d. Program and Departmental Development:
 - Must have participated in at least two (2) projects for clinical or administrative development that was approved by the manager. (Approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.)
 and,
 - ii. Must manage and present two (2) true north pillars (PDCA projects) each year.
- e. Ongoing Expectations of a PTA II:
 - Teaching and Mentoring. Must mentor or provide professionally relevant instruction to the physical therapy staff, other professionals, or community members (which may include but is not limited to in-services, professional presentations, and community outreach) will be an outgoing expectation.
 - ii. Program and Departmental Development.
 - a. Will manage and present two (2) true north pillars (PDCA projects) each year.
 - b. Will develop or review and update one (1) departmental program or protocol, or will participate in at least one (1) project for clinical or administrative development, each year.

(Where manager approval is required in the criteria above, approval shall not be withheld merely for purposes of preventing an employee from ascending the clinical ladder.)

The Union reserves the right to withdraw, modify, or otherwise amend its proposals in the course of the negotiations until such a time as the parties reach a tentative agreement.
