Employers almost never give ground during or immediately after a strike because they don't want to reveal how impactful strikes can be. So, it wasn't surprising that management showed up to our negotiating session completely unprepared to bargain and made no movement whatsoever.

The Bargaining Team didn't waste time. Following management's abysmal response, we went straight back to the picket line to stand strong with our coworkers.

We remain united, energized, and committed to winning the contract we deserve. Solidarity forever!
