Number of employees have tested positive for COVID after August 28?

R- 6 (No NUHW members have tested

positive for COVID 19). Management reported they have been doing contract tracing and the infection control nurse has provided CDC recommendations to employees that were exposed to an individual with COVID 19.

1. Tested positive for COVID-19 and at home? R-1

5. Continuing to work at facility following positive test without any symptoms? – R -None

WEEKLY COVID-19 TESTING IN SUB-ACUTE UNIT

- Testing September 14, 2020. This is due to a letter received from the California Department of Public Health.
- Sub-acute weekly test will be done using the nasal swab method.
- Employees who receive a COVID test every week in their second job, can present the negative result to avoid being tested at WAMC.
