



WE'RE PICKETING AGAIN FOR WORKERS' SAFETY - AUGUST 5

We held an informational picket at Kindred Westminster on July 22 to protest management's refusal to implement safeguards to protect workers and patients from COVID-19.

Our spirited picket received support from numerous community organizations and elected officials in Orange County, as well as print and broadcast news coverage.

We're holding another informational picket on Wednesday, August 5, to continue putting pressure on Hospital Management.

Our demands:

- Establish a dedicated COVID-19 unit. Mixing infected and possibly infected patients with "clean" patients is not safe for anyone.
- Provide adequate PPE, including N-95 masks, to all staff
- Provide adequate training on the proper use of PPE
- Ensure adequate staffing to protect everyone's safety
- Test all workers for COVID-19 twice per month
- Provide fair hazard pay for workers
- Provide quarantine pay for workers
- Participate in weekly labor-management meetings

Please join us and let management know we will not be ignored!
