Your stewards and bargaining committee are planning to present Kaiser a 10-day strike notice next week for a strike to begin on Monday, Aug. 15. These two Town Halls will be an opportunity to get more information about the impending strike and to ask questions. Everyone is urged to attend one of the Town Halls.

Moments before each Town Hall, everyone will receive a call asking them to remain on the line if they wish to participate. Anyone who misses the call will receive a message with instructions on how to join the Town Hall.
