Summary of candidate's NUHW questionnaire



PRIORITIES AS PRESIDENT

- Expand access to quality health care services
- Rebuild our national infrastructure
- Transition to a clean energy economy
- Improve early childhood and K-12 education
- Broaden access to higher education

HEALTH POLICY

- Supports Medicare-for All. The plan she has proposed would still allow for private insurers to operate in a tightly regulated market.
- She also has proposed a 10-year transition period to a Medicare-for-All system.

WORKER RIGHTS

- Supports banning employers from hiring permanent replacements for striking workers.
- As a U.S. senator, co-sponsored laws that would ban states from passing “right-to-work” laws, penalize corporations that violate the rights of workers to organize and collectively bargain, and codify the “card check” system for union elections.
- Supports raising the federal minimum wage to \$15 per hour.

MENTAL HEALTH PARITY

- Introduced mental health and Telemedicine Expansion Act to increase access to services, particularly in communities that don’t have enough mental health clinicians.
- Introduced bill to authorize a new educational loan repayment program for mental health professionals who agree to practice in areas with a shortage of mental health professionals.

IMMIGRANT RIGHTS

- Would fight for comprehensive immigration reform that includes a pathway to citizenship for 11 million undocumented individuals.
- Would immediately reinstate DACA and DAPA.
- Would use executive action to create a pathway to citizenship for DREAMers.
- Would restore and expand Temporary Protected Status for immigrants whose safety would be imperiled if forced to return home.
